

Qld Cricketers' Club Members Code of Conduct

The Qld Cricketers' Club is a private club with public responsibilities. Members are united in their desire to uphold the highest standards of behaviour to:

- protect the health and safety of the Club's employees and contractors
- ensure the provision of a safe, respectful and enjoyable environment for members & their guests
- protect the ability of the Club to execute its public responsibilities to manage the Club
- protect the reputation of the Club

The Queensland Cricketers' Club encourages a positive, enjoyable and fun atmosphere, where Members can support and cheer on their teams, exhibit passion and excitement at the game and share in this enjoyment with fellow Members & guests.

However, as Members, we share the responsibility to uphold the highest standards of behaviour. On joining the Club, Members agree to be bound by this Code and in particular to not behave in an unbecoming or dishonourable manner. This includes, but is not limited to:

- offensive, discriminatory, racist, sexist, aggressive or otherwise inappropriate discourse or actions towards any other person
- harassment of any kind
- unwanted physical contact
- drunk or disorderly conduct
- unsafe or unlawful conduct
- abuse of, or inappropriate conduct towards, staff members
- non-compliance with instructions given by staff member
- consumption of alcohol in non-designated areas
- possession or use of illicit substances
- misuse of membership card and entitlements
- acting dishonestly in any dealings with the Club
- any behaviour that brings the Club into disrepute

As a member you are expected to know the rules and apply them. It is your responsibility to ensure your guests also understand the Club's expectations of them. The Club may take disciplinary action when behaviour is contrary to the expectations set out in this Code. That action can include suspension or expulsion from the Club.
